Jeff Koch, the owner, presented plans to cut a second driveway to the duplex. Based on Section 2.7, Singletree Design Guidelines, the request was denied by the Architectural Consultant. The existing driveway is very challenging, and the existing hammerhead does not function as a turnaround and is at approximately an 11% grade. The proposal would include regrading the hammerhead and turn it into a second driveway entrance onto Singletree Road. This would include approximately 200 sq ft of new concrete and a new culvert. The goal is to maintain the mature aspen trees around the driveway. The new driveway could support both units.

The Committee listened to the presentation and reviewed the proposed plans presented for the second driveway cut onto Singletree Road. Following discussion, by motion duly made and seconded, it was (Viele opposed)

- a. A fully dimensioned site plan with materials shall be submitted, reviewed, and approved by the Architectural Consultant prior to construction.
- b. Final sign off from Eagle County is required.

**RESOLVED** to a second driveway cut onto Singletree Road subject to the conditions above.
