#### A WARM WELCOME FROM THE MONKEYS IN UBUD

The heart and soul of the island of Bali is Ubud! It is a peaceful, spiritual town known for its temples and wealth of cultural traditions. Ubud is surrounded by jungles and rice fields making the feel so... tropical. There are temples everywhere, everywhere! The people watching was amazing as the locals busily went about their days and the tourists lazily strolled the streets. After meeting up with my new friends, we headed out of town to our first educational experience. In the village of Subak Guliang, we visited a rice farm and were able to learn and assist in the planting of rice. The Balinese view rice as a gift from God and a symbol of life. She tried to give me the sarong for free. I gave her twice the price and we took pictures. People are wonderful. I want to live here.

In the afternoon, we headed to Tampak Siring, or the Holy Spring Temple. We were to take part in a water purification ceremony in the cleaning pool of the temple. This is serious temple-ing. We had to remove our clothes and put on their robes. We prayed in a beautiful garden and then proceeded to the springs to be blessed under the many fountains. About time I got purified!

And that evening, we enjoyed a Balinese Dance. The dance was a story of their people long ago. They keep their history alive in such creative ways. This beautiful and dramatic performance was one of many highlights of Ubud.

#### THE MAGNIFICENT TEMPLES OF YOGYAKARTA. JAVA

We flew to Yogyakarta on the island of Java in a quest to see the most amazing temples in the world. We found them. Prambana was breathtaking at first sight. I was awestruck. We were in monsoon rain but it was hardly

It is the largest 10th century temple compound in Indonesia and dedicated to the Hindu deity Shiva. We met a local guide who gave us a tour and told us the meaning of the vast temple. I had the opportunity to go into a very dark, damp room and whisper a wish into a giant stone oxen's ear. I am certain it will come true.

On to the Borobudur Temple, the world's largest monument to Budda that dates to the 8th and 9th centuries. Once again, jaw-dropping.



It is immense with 70+ Buddhist shrines that adorn 10 pyramid terraces

which represent the stages one must achieve before attaining Buddhahood (that is a real word).

Fun Fact: Women can become monks. Is this another calling? I like monkey whisperer.

In the afternoon, we took bicycles through a lush local village and made stops along the way visiting people, their family compounds, and taking music lessons. Yes, we stopped at a hut with all kinds of xylophones along with an instructor. We took turns making horribly good music together. At one stop, an elderly woman came out of her hut and I went over to speak with her, along with my guide, Sumantra. I asked her how long she had lived there and how many kids she had. 








#### **BOYS LACROSSE**

# Savannah Desportes and Cherie Rollins: Empowering Their Futures at Colorado Mountain College

From high school to higher education and beyond, CMC provides opportunities for lifelong learning and personal growth, empowering individuals at every stage of their journey

This is the second in a three-part series about Singletree residents who are Colorado Mountain College (CMC) alumni. The first article in our July issue chronicled Karen Kern's educational pathway to an associate degree in the 1980s. What follows are the stories of two other residents and their diverse learning experiences at CMC.

#### GETTING A STEP AHEAD WITH DUAL ENROLLMENT COURSES DURING HIGH SCHOOL

Eighteen-year-old Savannah Desportes, a 2024 Battle Mountain High School graduate, grew up in Singletree and attended public elementary, middle, and high schools practically within walking distance of her home. While in high school, she started taking Concurrent Enrollment Programs Act (CEPA) classes at the Colorado Mountain College Vail Valley at Edwards campus. CEPA classes, also known as Dual Enrollment or DE classes at area high schools, enable high school students to take college-level courses and earn college credits while still in high school. For the most motivated students, an associate degree is attainable during high school. In fact, CMC Vail Valley at Edwards graduated 13 local high school students this spring who attended their CMC graduation and received an Associate of Arts degree the week before they attended

their respective high school graduations!

Although Savannah did not get her associate degree, she did take three CEPA classes at CMC during high school, earning nearly a semester's worth of credits that will transfer to her undergraduate university in the fall.

Savannah recalls that her favorite CMC course was DE

Composition. "Even though it was strenuous at times (most of the time), I feel as though it really did prepare me for college level-classes and a collegelevel workload," she says. "I also love writing but had never done it to this degree. The next time I get a 15-page paper [assigned to me] in college, I'll know what to do!"

Initially, Savannah signed up for Concurrent Enrollment Programs Act courses to better prepare herself for the rigors of university-level coursework, especially in subjects she was passionate about. What she didn't expect was the more conversational and inclusive presentation style, as well as the lack of "teaching to a test" that she had experienced in her Advanced Placement (AP) classes. "[Dual Enrollment] classes ended up being a lot more free form in the sense that you're not following a set curriculum to prepare for one big test at the end of the year, as you might for an AP class," Savannah says. "The material I learned ended up being a lot more applicable and useful in the long run."

As Savannah prepares to enter the University of Arkansas in the fall to study interior design and architecture, she is already seeing the pay-off – quite literally – of the fruits of her labor. "As a result of taking [Dual Enrollment] classes in high school, I have [been able to skip] some entry-level classes, where there tend to be a lot of students in the class, which can be overwhelming," she says. "I can now just go straight into my major and dedicate my time to what I am passionate about and better prepare for my future career." The credits she earned at CMC were paid for through a partnership with the Eagle County School District, so Savannah will also pay less for college in the long run (which her mom will talk about in our next CMC article).

Savannah hopes to open her own interior design firm someday and says taking Dual Enrollment classes at CMC was worth the extra work in high school. "A lot of people worry about [DE] class credits not transferring over automatically as they would with an AP course, but the workload and challenge of taking these classes will pay off as they prepare you to go into a college environment," Savannah says. Although there is a perception that Dual Enrollment course credits will only transfer to public universities in Colorado (it is a Colorado state law for public colleges and universities in Colorado to accept these transfer credits), CMC students have transferred their credits to public and private universities all over the country, including many Ivy League institutions, according to CMC's website.

#### WHEN ONE DOOR CLOSES... FULFILLING A LIFELONG DREAM TO BECOME A TEACHER

In addition to CEPA classes, associate degrees, professional certificates, and non-credit community classes, what many locals don't know is that CMC also offers eight bachelor's

degrees. CMC is what is known as a Dual Mission institution. According to CMC's website, "CMC was officially designated as Colorado's first Dual Mission institution in 2021. Dual Mission colleges and universities offer a blend of certificate programs and associate degrees as well as bachelor's degrees under one roof. They recognize that today's learners need and want a mix of liberal arts and hands-on career skills training."

One of the most popular bachelor's degrees on the CMC Vail Valley campus is the Bachelor of Arts in Education. Singletree resident Cherie Rollins, who has lived in Edwards since 1997, knows first-hand how life changing an affordable neighborhood campus can be for Vail Valley residents. After being unexpectedly laid off from a 15-plus year banking career in 2013, she worked for a summer semester at CMC. "I discovered they had a very new, four-year degree for teachers," Cherie says. "I had always wanted to be a teacher so with an unexpected door open, I walked through and began the path toward [a teaching] certification."

Cherie graduated with her bachelor's in Education from CMC in 2018 and admits that being close to home for school was a big part of what drew her into the program. "It was so imperative to be close to home, because when a teacher goes through university classes, much of the time he or she works for free as a student teacher in local classroom settings," Cherie says. "In order to work part-time, be a fulltime student as well as a full-time mother, being close was indispensable to fulfilling obligations, while still being there for my children."

Taking the courses she needed was not always close or local for Cherie and she did have to make sacrifices to finish her degree. Sometimes classes on one campus are offered during the day, while others are only offered in the evenings, and students must travel to meet the requirements of their degree programs. "One semester, I took classes in Glenwood Springs so I could be in school during the day while my kids were also in school," she says. Cherie drove about an hour each way during the day so that she could be with her kids at night. Cherie made the drive because, she says, "I missed seeing them at dinner!"









In addition to being an accessible, local college with small class sizes, individualized tutoring and counseling opportunities, students of all ages and backgrounds find someone to lean on as part of the mentoring programs at CMC. Cherie's experience was no different, even though she was a nontraditional student, and she quickly found a mentor in Cristin Lasser, a fulltime CMC faculty member in the Education program at the time. "Cristin Lasser was amazing at holding high expectations, which ensured I'd be completely prepared when I set foot in the classroom," says Cherie. Leticia Burbano, affectionately known as "Lety" by her students, was also influential. "Lety was always there for me in the way of social-emotional support," Cherie says.

"She brought her own true-life experiences as motivation that I can do anything, as long as I am willing to work hard, practice, and am personally motivated to achieve."

Cherie now teaches first grade at Edwards Elementary School (EES), a 50/50 model bilingual school just a short walk from CMC's Edwards campus. For the 2024-25 school year, she will be teaching third grade English at EES, which will allow her to focus on important skills for kids who have already learned how to read. "I will be helping students focus on 'reading to learn.' I am excited for this new experience!" she says. A lifelong learner, Cherie hopes to continue her own education by earning a master's degree in education once her children have graduated from high school.

#### The Sentinel of Singletree: Behind the Scenes with Our Community Manager


From snow removal to nuisance bears, covenant compliance to neighborhood disputes, dues collection to social events, Nina Timm turns tasks into triumphs every day

ow would you feel if half the people you deal with every day walk away from your office, hang up the phone, or delete your email with feelings that range from bitter disappointment or extreme frustration to outright anger? Welcome to Nina Timm's world. For those of you who don't know Nina or what she does, Nina carries the job title of Community Manager for the Singletree Property Owners Association, SPOA. She is the person that must deal with every issue that faces our community from snow removal to nuisance bears, covenant compliance to neighborhood disputes as well as common space maintenance, dues collection, and social events!

So, who is Nina Timm, and how did she end up as the tip of the spear of everything Singletree? Let's start with her job title. "Community Manager" is a pretty vague description of the true range of her responsibilities. A more descriptive title might be "Neighborhood Wizard", "District Decider", or even "Local Sisyphus" after the figure from Greek





mythology who was condemned to the endless task of pushing a huge boulder up a never-ending hill.

Like so many of us over the years, Nina moved to the Valley with a friend in 1992 to spend a year as a ski instructor after graduating from the University of Minnesota and before getting real about life. The ski instructor part of the story never happened because she started working at the now-defunct Gore Range Mountain Works in the Village selling ski clothing and gear to locals and tourists. After three years there, she was recruited by Alfalfa's, the former natural foods outlet located in Crossroads. From there, she brought her talents to the Town of Vail where she served for 17 years, eventually directing the town's housing program.

She was appointed to her present position with SPOA in 2016 and since then has successfully weathered the slings and arrows of keeping the peace in a diverse community with varying interests that, at times, seem to know no bounds.

A bit of history might help here. In 1979, the Berry Creek Metro District created the Singletree community and platted the over 1,000 lots that make up our community. At the time, Edwards was little more than a wide spot in the road, so they encouraged potential homebuilders by creating a "live and let live" community. There was no design review board during those early years, so the design criteria could best be described as guidelines rather than actual regulations. As long as a proposed home met all

the Eagle County building codes, architects, builders, and homeowners were pretty much given free rein to indulge their imaginations and whims with little or no interference by the Metro District. It wasn't until 1995 that the Singletree Property Owners Association and the Design Review Committee were established. It was then that things got a bit more complicated to say the least. All of a sudden colors mattered, landscaping mattered, and dwelling height and footprint mattered.

Nina's job now means that she must be one part advocate, two parts arbiter, three parts the patience of Job and just a dash of Wonder Woman in case situations require just a bit of ass kicking. As Nina explained it during our interview, she has fifteen bosses: the five members of the Design Review Board, the five members of the Berry Creek Metro District Board, and the five members of the SPOA Board. In my view she left out a huge number of folks who, from time to time, might consider themselves her boss... the homeowners, both full and part time.

That kind of organizational chart would probably deter most folks from even considering taking on the task of Community Manager, but Nina seems to relish the job. She truly enjoys the many opportunities to bring us together at one of the many community events she helps organize every year as well as the endless birthday parties we have all seen as we drive past the playground and community center on our way home.

Despite the many concerns, pleas, and disputes that clog her voicemail and inbox every day, she still affirms that she truly loves working with people even though, as I mentioned earlier, half the people she meets with during the day leave disappointed because

either the addition they wanted to make to their home encroached on the setback, or she was unable to resolve a neighbor situation to the total satisfaction of the complainant (this is where the "two parts arbiter" of her job kicks in). It's important to remember, that, at the end of the day, Nina is not the decider in most of these situations that she deals with; she is the messenger delivering the ruling that has been decided by
